President's Message

Going to the New Normal

Due to the consequence of the coronavirus, experts are saying that things in our world won't ever be the same. There will be a new normal. One expert said a face mask will be the new seatbelt. Everyone will wear one. One Sunday during our Stay at Home Directive, I was listening to Pastor Steven Furtick on TV. He preached about this very thing. The title of his sermon was "Going to the New Normal". The scripture he used for the basis of his sermon was Exodus 14. Pharaoh and his army were chasing down the Israelis as they were trying to leave Egypt on their way to the Promise Land via the Red Sea. In response to fear and anxiety, the nation of Israel wanted to return to the old life of slavery rather than believing in the promise God had given them. Think about what they would have lost if they hadn't followed Moses. Read further in the Old Testament to hear the rest of the story.

Isaiah 55:9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts."


Ephesians 3:20 "Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us."

- Practice "Safe Distancing"

BACK TO CHURCH PROTOCOL

- † Badger Bounce Back Phase 2 allows up to 50 people. If attendance expected more than that 2 services necessary.
- † Masks are MANDATORY. Please bring your own; we do have a small † supply if you don't have one.
- Videotaping will be discontinued, however audio will be uploaded on You Tube for those not attending in person(see page 5 for more information.)
- † No coffee or food will be served so between-service fellowship.
- † Bathroom may be used ONE person at a time.
- + Any person feeling ill SHOULD not attend church gatherings. Persons having symptoms for coronavirus, flu, cold or any reason should stay at home.

- Greeter or meeting facilitator- wears mask and will have doors open for attendees. Attendees should have no contact with doors.
- † Hand sanitizer, spare face masks, (we encourage you to bring your own face mask) and Kleenex available in Narthex. Masks and sanitizer use are mandatory.
- + Seating should be immediate upon arrival. Please use safe distancing protocols, family units can sit together, allow 6 feet between others not in your family unit. Usher will dismiss congregation one row at a time starting in rear. Members to exit immediately.
- † Bibles, hymnals, song books will not be used during worship. The readings and hymns will be in the bulletin or on the screen. Personal bibles may be used.
- + All family units shall sit 6 feet apart. Every other pew will be blocked off to insure safe distancing.
- During Communion, Communion Assistant shall wear mask. Wine tray shall contain only 1/4 the normal number of cups. Safe spacing between cups insures no contamination. Communion will be done similar to intinction.
- † Family units can take communion together. Family units shall maintain 6 foot spacing going to communion.
- t Offering is collected in baskets on pedestal upon exiting.
- † And, obviously, NO hugs or handshaking during this time.

TRINITY'S ONLINE FUTURE

With the return of worship services on June 7, onsite at Trinity, there will no longer be a need for the YouTube videos that Pastor Barb Kleven and Joanne Schilling have been collaborating on since the COVID-19 Safer-at-Home rules went into effect. So, the video posted for May 31, will be the last video at this time. However, it does not mean the end of our YouTube channel – see more below!

Hopefully, the weekly videos helped our Trinity family to continue to receive the Word and celebrate the Sacrament elements of worship, albeit in the privacy of our own homes. (Come on, confess, how many were still in their jammies?!)

We received much positive feedback for our videos, and greatly appreciate that. Barb and Joanne learned something new every week, as they made their way thru the technological and legal challenges of creating and uploading videos to YouTube! And although some would like them to continue, the time and effort required in the process of producing just a 30-minute video forgoes that option.

The Process. Each week, Barb and Joanne coordinated via emails and texts on the details of the worship video. Which scripture reading (s) would be the focus of her message, what song would work well that was covered by our CCLI license (but needed to be sung by Barb to avoid copyright issues of other online performances), what images would help support the message that were available without violating copyrights, etc. That "pre-production" work could often involve several hours of research.

Then, Joanne would record Barb using a cell phone, after which Joanne then connected all the pieces into the final video, and then uploaded it to the big YouTube cloud in the sky. The "post-production"

portion after recording usually took between 4-5 hours weekly, provided there weren't any glitches. The uploading of the video itself usually took at least an hour depending on our usually slow internet connection speed here in beautiful Birchwood.



Online Future. It is expected that some members will be hesitant to come back into the building or even attend the outdoor service, immediately. So, we looked into the option of live-streaming, and found that the cost of obtaining equipment and copyright licenses was a bit prohibitive. The decision was made to continue our pre-COVID-19 practice of recording the <u>audio</u> of our worship service and extract the sermon portion to upload to our YouTube channel. Audio CDs will be available for those who do not have access to YouTube, and can be obtained by calling the church office and requesting one.
